### **BEGINNING OF LENT**

Dear Parishioners, Lent begins this year on Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>. This is a special time of preparation for those entering the Church and for all the baptized to renew our profession of faith at Easter. Some things you will note during the Mass in Lent is that the altar is typically not adorned with flowers, except for Laetare Sunday, Solemnities, and special Feasts; the Alleluia is not sung; and the Gloria is omitted except for certain days.

### BLESSED PALM AND ASH WEDNESDAY

The ashes for Ash Wednesday are usually prepared by burning blessed palm from Palm Sunday of previous years. If you have any blessed palm from previous years, you are welcome to bring it to the church to be burned. We will place a basket at the entrance of the church from Saturday, February 11<sup>th</sup> until Sunday, February 19<sup>th</sup> in which you can leave your blessed palm.

<u>SANCTUARY LAMP-</u> For the week of February 5th - 11<sup>th</sup> the Tabernacle Sanctuary Lamp will burn for special intention Bertha Noseworthy. The Sanctuary Lamp in the St. Thomas of Villanova shrine will burn for special intention Andrew Dawe.
